# Permitted Styles



French or "double" front entry doors and single front entry doors, of a solid style (no windows) are permitted, with 8 square inlays or 6 inlays. Eight inlays is the original development's style, but has become increasingly difficult to find available, so the six inlay style is now permitted.


### Conversion from Double to Single



Owner requests to convert a
French door to a single door with
"sidelights" may be permitted,
provided the specifications are in
line with the requirements and the
end result is consistent with other
sidelight doors in the community.
Please see the compliant examples
to the left and below.

The sidelight panels must be white and have the "mullion" grids as shown here. Owners have a choice of full sidelight panels of half solid/half windowed.

#### $\sum$ Windowed Door Options

Whether installing a new single front door or converting from double doors to a single door, the request for a windowed door may be approved, provided it is consistent with the requirements for windowed doors.

Window Option for Phases 1, 2, & 3 - High-set half-moon, paned window
