Guidance for Atrium Unit Owners

Registration/Licensing of Contractors/Maintenance Services (PA, Allegheny County, Pgh.)

HOME IMPROVEMENT CONTRACTORS

Home improvement contractors working in Pennsylvania must be registered with the State Office of Attorney General. This applies to contractors that repair, replace, remodel/renovate facilities in a unit, e.g., painting, installation of new bathrooms, kitchens, flooring, windows, doors, walls etc. Advantages of hiring a registered home improvement contractor:

- You are hiring someone that complies with State law
- When registering with the State, contractors must attest they carry liability insurance, have not been convicted of fraud, theft or other illegal actions
- Written contracts are required describing the work, price, timeframes, amount of liability insurance maintained by the contractor, limited right to rescind contract etc.

A HOME IMPROVEMENT CONTRACTOR SHOULD NOT PERFORM WORK THEY ARE NOT QUALIFIED

TO DO. For example, if a contractor doing a kitchen/bathroom renovation is not licensed as a plumber/electrician, and complex plumbing (e.g., new piping, new types of faucets/valves) or complex electrical work (e.g., new wiring, new circuit breakers, system current upgrades) is involved, this should be subcontracted out to licensed plumbers/electricians.

PLUMBERS, ELECTRICIANS AND HVAC (HEAT PUMP) CONTRACTORS

Plumbers, electricians and HVAC (heat pump) contractors must be licensed by the County/City. Advantages of hiring a licensed master plumber, licensed electrician / HVAC services:

- You are hiring someone that complies with Allegheny County / City of Pittsburgh laws
- The person has completed training/testing to verify their competence
- Defective plumbing work may result in leaks/property damage/mold etc. and insurance claims for your unit as well as for other units
- Defective electrical work may result in faulty wiring in your unit, leading to potential shock/fire hazard impacting your unit and other units
- Defective HVAC work may result in faulty wiring/piping and drain lines, and may cause water leaks in your unit as well as other units

IT'S IMPORTANT TO USE:

- Licensed master plumbers for complex jobs such as modification/installation of new piping behind walls, or for new complex plumbing fixtures
- Licensed electricians for complex jobs such as modification/installation of new wiring behind walls, installation of new circuit breakers, and electrical system upgrades.
- Licensed HVAC contractors when installing, enlarging, repairing, altering, removing, converting or replacing any HVAC system (heat pump)

Home Improvement (remodeling, repairs) Verify that your contractor has a Contractor Registration Number (HIC Number) issued by the Office of the Attorney General. Written contracts between contractors and homeowners are not required for work less than \$500.
Plumbing Verify that your contractor/plumbing service has a valid Master Plumber's License required by Allegheny County Health Department. To verify, see http://webapps.achd.net/Plumbing/ County Code: https://ecode360.com/8488067#8488068 Small, less complex plumbing tasks can be performed by a contractor that is not a licensed master plumber, such as burn not limited to: changing a sink faucet/valve, replacing are exposed existing in-kind drain pipe under a sink, unclogging a toilet.
Ask your contractor/electrical service company if they have an Electrical Trade License required by City of Pgh. City Code: https://pittsburghpa.gov/pli/electrical-trade-license https://library.municode.com/pa/pittsburgh/codes/code_of_ordinances?nodeld=COOR_TITSEVENBULI_ARTVTROC_CH747ELTRLI
Ask your contractor/HVAC service company if they have a Mechanical/HVAC Trade License required by City of Pgh. City Code: https://pittsburghpa.gov/pli/hvac-trade-license https://library.municode.com/pa/pittsburgh/codes/code of ordinances?nodeld=COOR TITSEVENBULI ARTVTROC CH741METRLI Small, non-complex tasks associated with heat pumps may not require a licensed HVAC contractor, such as burnot limited to: changing a hear pump filter (assure appropriate MERV/efficiency rating for your heat pump), resetting a hear pump.
